If player is new to club we still need to know the years of experience. Players must be listed in teams. **Forms will be returned if not filled in correctly.**

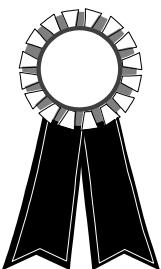
Please make sure you aware of all issues of privacy concerning your club members. Ask your players, parents if they wish to their information to be kept private and if photographs can be taken

Items for information & discussion at Club Level for Voting at the AGM

1. Fees

The recommendation of the Executive Committee is the Affiliation Fees for the 2017
Association Courts \$375 per team (Affiliation Fee \$255 plus Facility Fee of \$120, also includes 1 program book & includes GST)
Suburban Courts \$246 per team (Affiliation Fee \$185.50 plus Facility Fee of \$60.50, also includes 1 program book & includes GST)

2. Insurance The Insurance is compulsory.

Negotiations are under way. Hopefully we will know by the AGM.

3. Patron The Executive Committee recommends that Mrs Joy Smith be appointed as Patron for the year 2017
